Itinerary:

DAY 1

- Arrive at your cabin location from Peace River, Grande Prairie, Edmonton or Calgary
- Organize meal supplies for preparation in your modern cabin kitchen and barbeque (5 breakfasts, 5 evening meals)
- Optional first night and first continental breakfast kitchen stocking is available @\$35 pp
- Evening cocktail reception with guide to review itinerary

DAY 2

- Experience some of the best scenery of the majestic Peace River in a canoe or kayak. Suitable for beginners
- Shuttle upstream to paddle start point
- Travel the route of explorers and fur traders with a part day paddle
- Arrive Historic Dunvegan Park, enjoy the park including interpretive centre, garden center, mini golf
- Lunch at the park included
- Travel back to accommodation
- Evening to relax and explore

DAY 3

- Early morning guided hike to discover the unique ecosystem of the river hills.
- Travel to a local museum with lunch at the local favourite, Farmer's Restaurant, followed by a visit to an iconic viewpoint of the Peace River
- Lunch included

DAY 4

- Canoe or kayak day paddle on the Peace with some exploratory hikes to little known venues. Suitable for beginners.
- Lunch on the river included

DAY 5

- Optional tours: a) birdwatching b) Pioneer museum c) local farm d) scenic ultralight flight. Lunch included
- Afternoon and evening to yourself

DAY 6

- Check-out and travel home

Included: First night cocktail reception, 5 nights accommodation, transportation for tours, all lunches, all gear and guide, for trips and tours

Optional Add- Ons subject to availability:

- 1) First evening meal and first continental breakfast kitchen stocking available @\$35 pp
- 2) Ultralight Flight (weather dependent) \$95 pp, ½ hr flight
- 3) Unlimited hiking or upstream paddling as desired. Additional guided padding \$40 per hour, self-guided \$10 per hour
- 4) Wood fired hot tub: \$100 including firewood
- 5) Golfing at one of multiple local courses
- 6) \$500 single supplement or we will match singles in shared accommodation with someone of the same sex if possible.

Important policies to note:

- 1) **Availability:** this package is available May to October, in July and August availability is Tuesday to Sunday only
- 2) **Reservation policy:** Bookings are only confirmed with receipt of full payment, or minimum deposit of 50% of invoice. MasterCard, Visa or E-transfer.
- 3) **Cancellation policy:** 30 days prior to stay- full refund of deposit, 29 to 15 days prior to stay, 50% refund of deposit, 14 days and under- \$250 pp deposit retained.
